From the Administrator's Desk-

Belated Christmas Greetings to you, and I hope you are as excited for the New Year as we are at VDM! We extend our most gracious THANK YOUs for all the goodies and treats that were sent to the staff this holiday season. Everything was delicious, and very appreciated!

As we ring in 2022, we feel closer to a sense of "normal" than we have in a long time. However, with news of a new variant, we are reminded that we aren't quite there yet. As our partners in care, we need your help to keep our residents as safe as possible. With the new year upon us, I thought I might share some reminders as to procedures, and I am asking that you please share these with others in your family/friend circles who might want to visit us:

All visitors must go through COVID screening prior to entering the building. We ask, however, that if you are sick or have been exposed to a COVID positive person (especially with active symptoms) that you consider delaying your visit until you are well.

Due to limited space, only one person can visit each resident at any one time in their room. We ask that you stay with the resident you are visiting and pull the privacy curtain. Please do not wander around the facility.

If you wish to have more than one person visit at a time, please contact our Receptionist at (412) 361-2833 and reserve our Visitation Area in the lobby.

We're all so attuned to COVID that we sometimes forget there are other illness floating about, such as Influzena and Norovirus. Even if you test negative for COVID, please consider delaying visiting our residents if you have symptoms such as nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and/or other gastrointestinal issues.

Hand sanitizer is readily available throughout the facility, including: the screening area, by the elevator, resident rooms. We encourage using it both before and after visiting.

Masks are available to all visitors in the screening area when you enter the building. Please take a mask to wear before entering.

We know so much more about this virus now than when we did in March of 2020. My hope for the new year is that when I am writing to you at the end of 2022, it's about ANYTHING other than COVID.
