Do's and Don'ts of Holiday Decorating Resident Rooms

Resident doorways may be decorated on the outside of the room (cannot impede the closing of the door.) No decorating on the inside of resident doors/doorknobs.

NO over-the-door wreath hangers are permitted.

NO nails, screws, hooks or tape is permitted for hanging decorations on doors. 3M hooks/command strips will be provided through a work request slip.

All lights brought into the facility must be inspected by Maintenance prior to use. All lights must have a UL listing or they will be rejected. Nothing hung on lights.

NO decorations or Christmas lights attached, draped or secured to the over-the-bed light. Christmas cards should be attached to the cork board provided in each room.

NO nails, screws/hooks/tape to hang decorations. 3M hooks/command strips will be provided through a work request slip.

NO extension cords or power strips are permitted to be used for Christmas lights or decorations.
